[VMRC Oyster Sample & Reporting Tool: A Decade of Effectiveness](#)

While ESRI has recently released version 10 of its ArcGIS platform, WorldView continues to provide support to clients on a variety of solutions, some of which were developed ten years ago and are still in production. The Virginia Marine Resources Commission continues to use a highly effective tool originally developed in 2000 by WorldView for oyster ground repletion sampling. Since 2000, VMRC staff have sampled oyster grounds to monitor restoration efforts. WorldView developed a wizard based tool in ArcView that provides a simple interface for creating random sampling areas and for entering the results from sampling. Ten years later, this solution remains an effective production tool used by VMRC staff in support of their sampling efforts.

A Decade of Partnership with The Conservation Fund

WorldView's first project, in July of 2000, was the development of a land use database layer for The Conservation Fund. In the intervening decade, WorldView has since completed over thirty projects for the Fund, including dozens of [rapid open space assessments](#) for the Civil War Preservation Trust; a series of [maps](#) that helped the Fund acquire lands once used as campsites to intern more than 120,000 Japanese-Americans during World War II; and most recently, the development of an [ArcGIS Server web portal](#) for the Fund's wide range of projects.

Top 10 New Features We're Excited About in ArcGIS 10

Perhaps it is merely a coincidence that ESRI released the latest version of its flagship product line, ArcGIS 10, this month, but we consider it an auspicious one that foreshadows promising futures for both ESRI and WorldView. The following is the WorldView Top 10 list of new features and enhancements in the ArcGIS 10 release:



10. Rapid cloud based deployment of ArcGIS Server is offered through the Amazon Elastic Compute Cloud (EC2)

9. ArcGIS for iOS allows developers to build and deploy custom applications for iPhone, iPad and iPod Touch

8. An enhanced data manager improves data check in and check out with ArcPad 10

7. Bing Maps base mapping data is offered for free to ArcGIS Desktop users and affordably priced for ArcGIS Server users

6. New feature service available for editing vector feature geometries and attributes via ArcGIS Server web applications

5. Perform keyword searches of the ArcMap symbol library's 20,000+ items with terms such as "green push pin"

4. Reorder fields using ArcMap layer properties

3. Map book / series automation tools are now included in ArcMap

2. Concurrent use license checkout capability is now offered through the License Manager

1. Improved, redesigned workflow-oriented editing interface that is layer-focused and new parcel data management and editing tools in ArcMap
